“Why, What and How education for the age of AI?”

Today experts from multiple disciplines belonging to Andhra University, GITAM University, Gayatri College, ANITS College and the Business Community of Visakhapatnam participated in a round table discussion about “Education in the age of AI” organized by Education Redesign a non-profit in partnership with GITAM School of Business.

“Artificial Intelligence (AI) today is more intelligent, has speed, scale and precision than humans, in such a world, why what and how should we be pursuing education?” with this question Professor Bala Veeramacheneni, Chairman of Education Redesign started the discussion. 85% of the jobs that today’s students will do in 2030 don’t exist yet, “the Institute for the Future” has predicted. 70 – 90% of the current jobs will be replaced by AI. When we don’t know what the future jobs are, how can we equip our students with the skills and mindset that will serve them well. The top 7 AI firms (including Anthropic, Google, OpenAI, Meta ...) have replaced 70% of software coding. Soon software will be done 100% by AI with commands in Natural Languages. The profession of computer programmers may become obsolete. In 2024-25, AI solved some of the unsolved problems in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Medicine, Energy, and Biology. If AI is able to deliver better research outcomes by just adding GPUs or improving the processing power using quantum computing, exceeding what researchers have been struggling to solve for decades. Professor Prasada Rao said education is not about academic pursuits alone, as Swami Vivekanand said it is about man-making.

Mr. Gopi Bulusu, CTO of Sankhya Technologies said that AI has to become a part of the curriculum at all stages of education. Prof. Suresh from GITAM computer science department suggested that in the age of AI, education must become multi-disciplinary. Prof. Kamakshaiah from GITAM School of Business said, the future of education is all about continuous learning. Dr. Vidya a Neuro Psychiatrist from GITAM Medical College said emphasis has to be on the human elements more than academics, especially in the age of AI.

Senior Professor Samba Murthy mentioned that policy makers should formulate inclusive laws to help the poor benefit from AI. They should ensure equity and access to education so that digital divide even in the age of AI is not perpetuated. Mr. Amal Raj, CEO of THE DIGIFAC Services, suggested setting up guardrails to ensure AI is not misused and at the core it has to be for the pursuit of human wellbeing. Finally, Mr. Raja Pappu, the Dean of GITAM School of Business, praised the participants and invited all to participate in the several upcoming conferences to be held in the GITAM School of Business in November and December 2025 on a wide variety of topics.

Professor Bala Veeramacheneni concluded by thanking GITAM School of Business for hosting this Colloquium and suggested participants to get involved in their working groups on “Developing an Action Plan for Education in India in the age of AI” and “Bharat AI – Curriculum and Pedagogical Development”
